Future Projects

- Welcome to Troy at main exit after its redone
 Keep in touch with the City/MoDOT so that we may work together. Something other than
 landscape so that it does not need much upkeep/maintenance Sarah suggested something like
 our Explore Troy App, EAT/SHOP/STAY. Look at a monument or statue. Maybe "Home of the
 Trojans" or something associated to the "Woods Fort" on Main/Boone.
- Main Street Planters water, replace & replant annuals
 Angie reached out to LCR3 FFA to inquire about their assistance with plant upkeep and installation. Rob Calvin confirmed that they participate in community service projects from time to time and that the typical investment is student labor to help an organization execute a plan. The board has concerns that the investment will not be kept up with in the long run and wants to consider a project more "one and done".

Angie suggested the installation of solar street lights along main street instead of planters. The board agreed to further review the expense of this suggested project and move forward from there.

- Boone Street Park (Flooding Issue)
 Landesign quoted \$15,397 in May of 2022 which included regrading the area incorporating sand in soil, rain garden native plantings, mulch & oversized rock.
- *Current funds of \$4,000 will be rolled over and added to the 2023/2024 budget
